8* MOTION – ON THE RELOCATION OF ALIMAOW DUMPSITE
(Hon. Mahat Mohamed Ibrahim)

Aware that Article 42 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides that every person has the right to clean and healthy environment.

Further Aware that article 43(1) (a) of the Constitution of Kenya provides that every person has the right to the highest attainable standard of health.

Noting that according to clause 87(1) of the Environmental Management and Coordination Act, Chapter 397 of 1999 (revised 2012), no person shall discharge or

dispose any waste whether generated within or outside Kenya, in such manner as to cause pollution the environment or ill health to any person.

Further noting that waste management is mostly the responsibility of the County Government.

Concerned that the County Government hasn't prioritized this thus resulting in poor waste management and indiscriminate dumping of all solid wastes including the medical and untreated human wastes in one site.

Further concerned that Ali Maow dumpsite in Furaha Location has become a source of distress for residents of both Furaha and Got-Rahma locations considering that odors emanating from the dumpsite, coupled with the potential pollution and attendant respiratory/eye infections and water borne diseases are jeopardizing the wellbeing of the residents.

Cognizant that His Excellency the Governor of Wajir has severally pronounced his intention to relocate the dumpsite to more appropriate location which is far from human settlements and his predecessor's written agreement with residents was not fulfilled and executed on the agreed timeline.

Now Therefore, this Assembly resolves the County Government of Wajir to; -

1. Take immediate and decisive action to initiate the relocation of Alimaow Dumpsite to a more suitable and environmentally appropriate location;
2. Allocate the necessary resources and collaborate with relevant stakeholders to ensure smooth and timely transition of the dumpsite.
